Most people experience gradual improvement in pain, strength and function over several weeks to months, as the tendon tissue slowly repairs itself.

#### What Are Peptides and How Do They Help?

Peptides are short chains of amino acids—essentially small proteins—that tell your body how to heal, grow, and recover. Think of them as biological messengers. In cases of chronic tendinitis, specific peptides can:

- Decrease inflammation
- Improve blood flow to the damaged tissue
- Stimulate collagen and tendon repair
- Accelerate overall recovery and reduce downtime

Commonly used peptides for tendon and joint recovery include BPC-157 (known for healing muscles, tendons and ligaments) and TB-500 (which promotes flexibility and tissue repair). These are typically given as small injections under the skin or near the affected area and can be used alongside PRP to boost the regenerative process.

#### Why Combine PRP and Peptides?

When used together, PRP and peptides can provide a powerful one-two punch for chronic tendon injuries:

- PRP jump-starts healing by delivering growth factors directly to the site of injury.
- · Peptides sustain and enhance that healing by supporting cellular repair, improving circulation and reducing inflammation system-wide.

Patients often report faster recovery, less pain and better long-term results compared to standard treatments alone. These therapies can also reduce the need for repeated cortisone shots or surgery.


Life can change in a moment. I learned this firsthand after the sudden and unexpected loss of my mom, Kathleene. She wasn't just the heart of our family—she was also the organizer, the planner, the one who quietly held the details of our lives together. For as long as I can remember, my mom had told us that when she died, she wanted to be buried with the love letters my dad wrote her while stationed in Hawaii during their early marriage. We all knew this, yet in the fog of shock and grief, her request slipped our minds. Afterward, we were devastated to realize we had forgotten.

This experience was a wake-up call. It showed me just how important it is to have conversations about wishes, memories, and details—big and small—before it's too late.



A month before my mom passed, someone gave me a little end-of-life planning book. I flipped through it and thought it was a good idea, but I didn't bring it up. I didn't want to "jinx" anything. I assumed we had plenty of time. But the very next month, she was gone, and I was left with so many unanswered questions.

That's why I now share *The What If Book: Be Ready for the Unexpected*. It's a resource born from my own story, designed to help families prepare in ways that go far beyond wills and financial planning. It's about capturing the personal details that define a life—the special recipes, the quirky habits, the cleaning tricks, the family stories, even the requests that might otherwise get lost in the shuffle of grief.

Think of it this way: if something happened to me and my husband tomorrow, my kids wouldn't even know what dog food to buy for our pugs—or where I buy it. To me, that's second nature. But to them, it would be just another stressful mystery on top of an already overwhelming situation.

My hope is that by sharing my story, families will see the value in documenting the details that truly matter. Whether it's traditions, personal wishes, or even those little "only mom knows" things, write them down. Share them. Talk about them.

## A Year to Celebrate Newport

As we look back on an extraordinary year in Newport Beach, I am deeply grateful for the opportunity to serve as Mayor during a time when our community continues to thrive. My theme for 2025, "Celebrate Newport," centers on honoring our unique history and recognizing today's accomplishments, while preparing the next generation to carry this remarkable city into the future.

One of my favorite expressions of this year's mayoral theme has been the historical presentations that start each City Council meeting. We've celebrated local pioneers who helped build our early economy, highlighted civic leaders who protected open space and preserved our quality of life, and learned more about the fascinating history of some of our most beloved community institutions. Each presentation reminded us that Newport Beach has always been defined by people who care deeply about their community and dream boldly about what comes next.



It has been a year of major progress on many fronts, including public safety. Focused operations along the Oceanfront Boardwalk have significantly reduced unsafe behavior and improved the Peninsula experience for residents and visitors. At the same time, the Newport Beach Police Department has expanded new technology tools — from FLOCK cameras to the City's first drone program — helping keep our neighborhoods safe and our response times strong. Successful enforcement of a stronger homeless ordinance enacted in late 2024 has resulted in a significant drop in homelessness throughout Newport Beach.

We've continued to deliver strategic investments that preserve our quality of life. The City Council adopted a balanced budget that protects essential services, strengthens long-term fiscal reserves, and pays down pension obligations to help maintain Newport Beach's prestigious AAA credit rating.

Work is underway on important infrastructure projects across the city, including the new Witte Hall lecture facility at the Central Library, upgrades to our Peninsula fire station and library branch, and the ongoing undergrounding of utilities on Balboa Island — all advancing toward completion. This year marked the opening of the City's first accessible playground for children of all abilities, at San Miguel Park, prompted by a heartfelt request from the sister of a disabled resident.

Stewardship of Newport Beach's natural beauty remains a cornerstone of our work. This year marked a major milestone with the launch of the Newport Bay Trash Interceptor, an innovative system that is capturing trash and debris before it can enter our



ecological treasure, the Upper Newport Bay Nature Preserve. This fall, the City began construction on the final phase of a significant environmental restoration project at Big Canyon Nature Park. This work will be the last piece of a decade-long restoration effort to transform degraded land along Back Bay Drive into a healthier, natural estuary that supports native species and enhances trails for all to enjoy.

Most importantly, we continue to invest in our future leaders. Programs like the Mayor's Youth Council give young people the opportunity to learn, volunteer and gain hands-on civic experience.

As my term as Mayor winds down, I'd like to express what an honor and privilege it has been to serve this wonderful community and to celebrate Newport through its history, achievements, and incredible people who make this city so special.
